WSCL Rule 11

Players wishing to change West Somerset League clubs during the season must inform the Secretary in writing and must enclose permission for the transfer signed by a responsible official from the club they are leaving. Permission should only be withheld for non-cricketing reasons (e.g. bad conduct, debt etc.). In the event of a dispute, the matter will be decided at the next Committee Meeting. Transfers must take place in time for the player to play in the last six fixtures for his new club. Once a player has played Saturday league cricket for another club, he may not play any more West Somerset league or cup matches for the club he has left. No player will be allowed to transfer at any time, even to a club in a different league, if he owes money to the club he is leaving.
